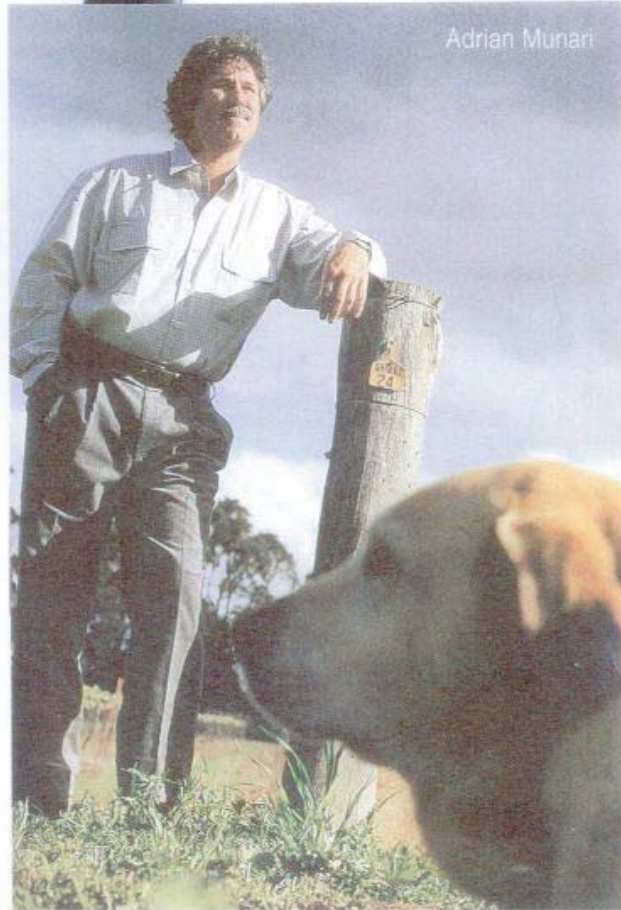


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HEATHCOTE

2002 Munari Lady Pass Shiraz \$33

Established in 1993 by Adrian and Deborah Munari, this eight-hectare property is well worth searching out, particularly if you are visiting the area, because it is one of the few cellars doors that is open seven days a week.

As with many of the wines from the centre of the GI, concentration of fruit is a key element. Super-intense with little oak evident, there are flashes of liquorice and tar and chunky black fruit that is backed by a powerful undercurrent of earthy/savoury tannins. Closes with a big kick of vibrant fruit. Wow, this is good: sublime concentration and composure, and so damned refined. A stunning 10-15-year cellaring proposition.
